Snorer Ashton Kutcher, 29, fixed his deviated septum, says an insider. But it looks like he may have done more! While a rep for Ashton denies it, Dr. Lorenc thinks the actor may have opted for a smaller sniffer, from tip to bridge. "It still looks masculine but just a little too narrow," he says about Ashton's possible feature-perfecting rhinoplasty (up to \$15,000).

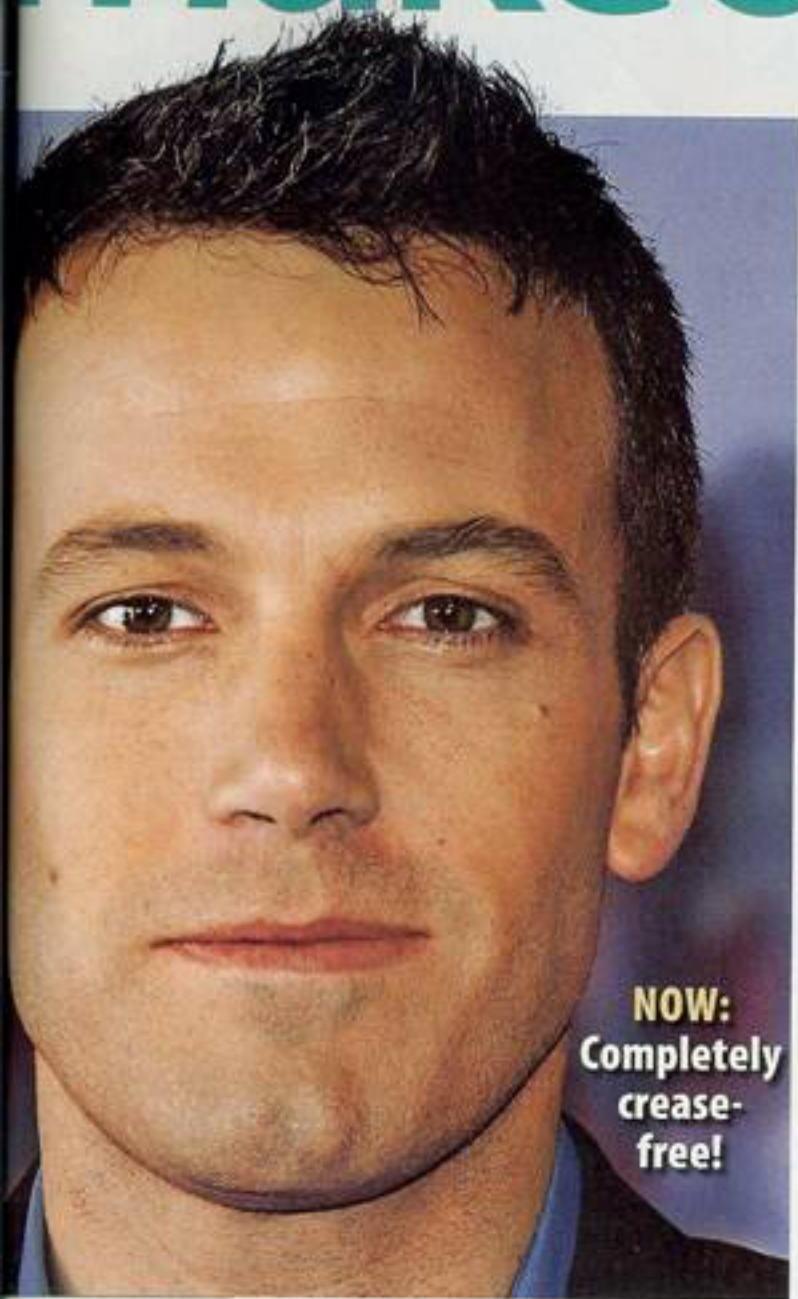

Jeremy has more hair!

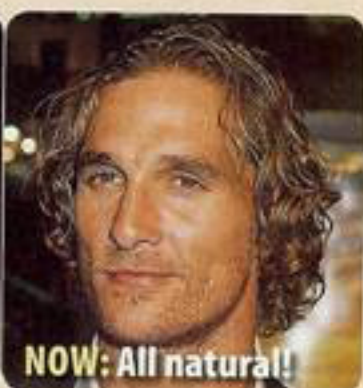

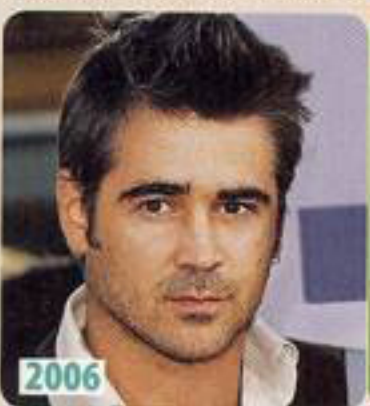
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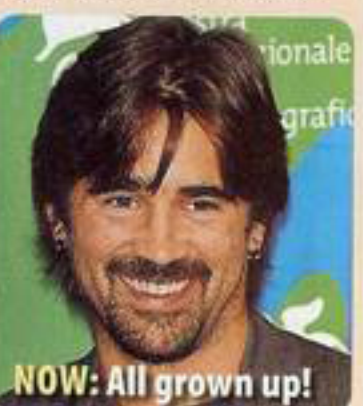
